ITEM 3 – DISCUSSION WITH POTENTIAL QUAY/VILLAGE LOBBYISTS - Warren Frost introduced the lobbyists with Hull Consulting, LLC that were for consideration. They provided a short presentation on the history of their company and who they have worked with. The discussion was to place emphasis on the issues around the Eastern New Mexico Water Utility Authority Ute Lake Pipeline. Consideration was given to the lack of information that many people had regarding feasibility of the project. The second priority was given to the Canadian River Crossing funding. They had met with Quay County earlier in the day and the County was considering the use. Village of Logan will sign a contract with the company for twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) and would have full say in the priorities or stances that would be taken. They would work under the direction of Administrator Paris.
