PUBLIC NOTICE

OPEN FIRE AND FIREWORK BAN

The Village of Logan Council has put into effect Ordinance No. 2014-184 adopted on April 15, 2014 – **An Ordinance relating to the ban of open fires, fireworks and the use of public property; regulating the use of fireworks and open fires and prohibiting the use of open fires and fireworks during periods when the Fire Chief and Governing Body finds that the fire danger is high; providing for penalty.** This will be in effect as of April 25, 2022 for a sixty (60) day period unless otherwise rescinded.

Due to abnormally warm temperatures, low humidity, high winds and the abundance of dry, fine fuels, fire danger throughout eastern New Mexico is high. Fire incidents for all wild land fire agencies are increasing daily pursuant to New Mexico Statutes Annotated, Section 68-2-16, and other sections of the Forest Conservation Act, NMSA 1978, Section 68-2-1 to 68-2-25, and 19.20.3 NMAC; Restrictions for Fire Prevention, the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Forestry Division has placed restrictions on Quay County. Copies from the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department are available at the Village office.
