The April 14, 2022, special meeting of the Village of Logan Council was convened at 4:30 p.m. at the Village office.

Mayor Babb called the meeting to order and presided during the meeting.

ITEM 1 - AGENDA – Upon a motion by Councilmember Osborn and seconded by Councilmember Courtney, the agenda was approved.

ITEM 2 – LODGERS TAX FUND REQUESTS - Clerk/Treasurer Rachor presented the requests submitted to the Lodgers Tax Advisory Board. The board met April 11, 2022 and allocated nine thousand, five hundred dollars (\$9,500.00) of the budgeted Lodgers Tax Funds for fiscal year 2021-2022.

Canadian River Renegades – Chuck Wagon Cook off - \$1,500.00
Logan Bass Club – Big Bass Tournament - \$1,500.00
Logan Chamber of Commerce – July 4th Celebration - \$6,500.00

Upon a motion by Councilmember Bass and seconded by Councilmember Shivers, Council unanimously approved the Lodgers Tax request as presented by the Lodgers Tax Advisory Board.

Councilmember Courtney stated that the Lodgers Tax Advisory Board recommended that the Council budget eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00) for signage entering Logan with the participation of the Logan Ute Lake Chamber of Commerce. There was a request for the community cleanup for next fiscal year and the event did not meet the criteria for funding. The next advisory meeting was scheduled for August 3, 2022.

ITEM 6 - ADJOURNMENT – Upon a motion by Councilmember Osborn and seconded by Councilmember Shivers, the meeting was adjourned.
