Article 3, 6-3-12 DISPLAY OF ADDRESS NUMBERS

PURPOSE:

Rapid identification of a specific premise by Police, Fire and EMT's is essential for the safety of residents, property and emergency personnel in the event of an emergency.

A. RESPONSIBILITY FOR DISPLAY OF ADDRESS NUMBERS.

It shall be the responsibility of each and every property owner, trustee, lessee, agent and occupant of each residence, apartment building, business or industry to post and maintain at all times address numbers assigned by the Village of Logan as required under this policy.

B. PLACEMENT OF ADDRESS NMBERS. ,

- 1. The responsible party for primary structures, which are located less than 50 (fifty) feet from the nearest road and which are clearly visible year round from the road, must erect and maintain their assigned address numbers on the outside of the primary structure not lower than 2 (two) feet above grade or higher than 8 (eight) feet above grade.
 - a. The address numbers shall be no smaller than 4 (four) inches tall and shall be coated with a reflective material. The address numbers shall present a strong contrast with the background color.
 - b. The occupant of the primary structure shall be responsible for keeping its address numbers clear of snow, dirt, debris or other obstruction.
- 2. Structures located more than 50 (fifty) feet from the edge of the road right-of-way shall comply with the previous requirement listed for structures within 50 (fifty) feet of the edge of the right-of-way or in addition shall:
 - a. Display the assigned address number on a post, fence or wall or other permanent structure no further than 10 (ten) feet back from the edge of the road right-of-way and no more than 6 (six) feet from the inner edge of the driveway.
 - b. The address numbers shall be composed of numbers that are not less than 4 (four) inches in height.
 - c. The sign shall be composed of reflective numbers on a contrasting background.

d. The numbers shall be not less than 4 (feet) and not more than 7 (seven) feet above the ground.

C. PENALTY.

After notification of being in violation of this ordinance, each day this ordinance is violated shall constitute a separate offense. Each violation shall be punishable as provided in Article 1, 6-1-2 of the Village of Logan Ordinances.
